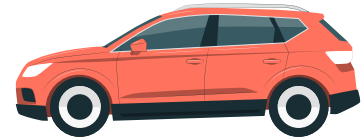


How To Get To Us



WALK / CYCLE

If you live nearby, bring a bike lock if cycling



CAR

Parking is available near the West Pier, but it can be busy.



BUS

Take Bus H3 or 6 and get off at Howth Harbour stop.



TRAIN

Take the DART train to Howth Station, then walk 5 minutes to the pier.





How Long is the Boat Tour

- Boat tour: **50 minutes**
- Getting on and off the boat: **about 10 minute**
- **If the weather is too windy, the tour may change. You can reschedule or get a full refund**





What Will Happen on the Boat

The boat tour will go around Ireland's Eye.

During the tour you may:

- See **cliffs** and **sea caves**
- Look for **seabirds** and **marine wildlife**
- Hear **stories about the area**

On the boat you can:

- **Sit** or **stand**
- Hold the **rails for safety**

Please listen to the crew at all times.

It's very important that you listen to the crew at all times.





What To Bring

Wear comfortable and warm clothes.

You may want to bring

- Rain jacket
- Hat
- Sunglasses
- Water
- Sun cream

The crew may also have hats or sunglasses if you need them





Who Can Come With Me

You can come with:

- A parent or guardian
- Family members
- A trusted support person

They can:

- Join the boat tour
or
- Wait nearby on the pier.





Toilets

Toilets are located:

- At the entrance to the West Pier
- Near Howth Train Station
- Opposite Howth Market

It is a good idea to use the toilet before the tour, because there are no toilets on the boat.
